



AMCNO 2022 Voter's Guide

This voter's guide created by the Academy of Medicine of Cleveland and Northern Ohio is meant as an informational reference for the upcoming elections on November 6, 2022. The AMCNO is not endorsing any of the following candidates. **This document is meant solely as an informational guide about the candidates and their healthcare aims.**

Information is also included on current politicians' votes for the following AMCNO priority legislation:

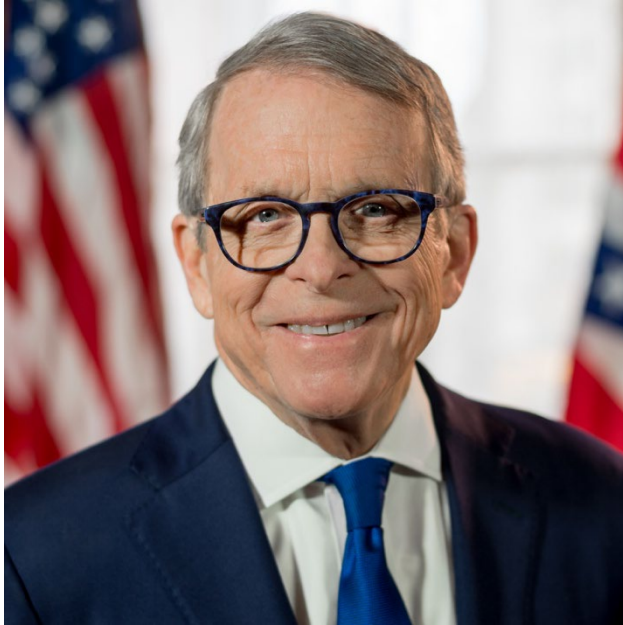
- **Senate Bill 23: Abortion Restrictions** – under the previous General Assembly 133
 - This law prohibits abortion in almost all circumstances if there is a detectable heartbeat in the fetus.
 - **The AMCNO opposed this legislation.**
- **House Bill 435: Anti-Vaccination**
 - This legislation would broaden vaccine exemptions in Ohio to allow most Ohio workers and students to refuse a COVID-19 vaccine requirement with a simple written statement. It would also prohibit state, county, and municipal public facilities from requiring proof of vaccination before entry.
 - **The AMCNO opposes this legislation.**
- **Senate Bill 22: Public Health Orders**
 - This law establishes legislative oversight over health orders, including blocking the health department from issuing any stay-at-home orders like those at the start of the COVID-19 pandemic. It also allows legislators to vote down health orders or emergency declarations without the governor's approval.
 - **The AMCNO opposes this legislation.**
- **House Bill 122: Telehealth**
 - This legislation expanded telehealth availability in Ohio by requiring health plans to reimburse healthcare professionals for providing covered telehealth services and expanding the classes of healthcare providers who are authorized to provide telehealth services.
 - **The AMCNO supported this legislation.**
- **House Bill 135: Patient Co-Pays**
 - This bill would prohibit certain health insurance cost-sharing practices like copay accumulation problems. This includes outlawing the refusal to use coupons or copays toward an out-of-pocket maximum.
 - **The AMCNO supports this legislation.**
- **Senate Bill 6: Interstate Medical Compact**
 - This law entered Ohio into the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact allowing physicians to quickly apply for and attain medical licensure in other participating states.
 - **The AMCNO supported this legislation.**

Mike DeWine (R)

- Has been in public office since 1977¹
 - Greene County Prosecutor, Ohio State Senate, U.S. House of Representatives, Lieutenant Governor of Ohio, U.S. Senate, Ohio Attorney General, & current Governor of Ohio
- Pro-life
 - Signed “Heartbeat Bill” and “Born Alive Infant Protection Act”²
- Ended COVID state of emergency in June 2021³



Nan Whaley (D)

- Former mayor of Dayton, Ohio⁴
- Was the second female mayor of Dayton⁵
- First woman nominated for governor in the state of Ohio
- Initiatives
 - Pro-choice⁶
 - Lower prescription drug prices⁷
 - Supports gun safety policies like requiring universal background checks⁸

Mike DeWine

- Endorsed by the National Rifle Association (NRA) and Ohio Right to Life⁹
 - Signed “Constitutional Carry” into law giving the right to carry arms without taking a firearms training course¹⁰
 - Signed HB 99 to allow authorized personnel to be armed in a school safety zone
- Formed and joined American Governors’ Border Strike Force in April 2022 to “disrupt and dismantle transnational criminal organizations”¹¹
- Created an executive order to ban new opioids

Nan Whaley

- Chose Cheryl Stephens, member of Cuyahoga County Council and former mayor of Cleveland Heights, as her Lieutenant Governor¹²
 - Would be first Black woman in this position
- Supports more oversight of guns in Ohio
 - Spoke against Governor DeWine saying he “has made Ohio less safe” by signing HB 99 along with other legislation that has made it easier for individuals to carry firearms in Ohio, including in school buildings

- Did not support Ohio’s unconstitutional redistricting¹⁷
- Endorsed by *Cleveland.com*’s Editorial Board¹⁸

Marilyn Zayas (D)

- Serves on First District Court of Appeals³⁰
- Has sat by appointment of Ohio's Chief Justice on the Ohio Supreme Court and the Second, Sixth, Eighth, and Tenth District Courts of Appeals³¹
- First Latina elected to an Ohio Court of Appeals³²
- Endorsed by *Cleveland.com*'s Editorial Board³³

Tim Ryan (D)

- Elected to the U.S. House of Representatives ten times³⁶
 - First sworn in in 2003
- Endorsed by Senator Sherrod Brown, Congresswoman Joyce Beatty, and Congresswoman Marcy Kaptur³⁷
- Health care issues
 - Pro-choice³⁸
 - Opposed Ohio's 20-week abortion ban in 2017
 - Supports the Affordable Care Act³⁹
 - Voted to protect access to birth control under federal law⁴⁰
 - Voted for H.R.8297 to guarantee that no woman can be prevented from or retaliated against for

 - Expand accessible addiction treatment

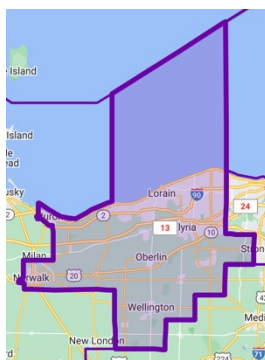
